MTE services approximately 2,029 square miles with more than 14,000 miles of line with 52 distribution substations distributing 8 billion kilowatt-hours of TVA-generated electricity annually. We primarily serve Cannon, Rutherford, Williamson and Wilson counties. Based on various factors, we also serve parts of Bedford, Cheatham, Coffee, Davidson, DeKalb, Dickson, Hickman, Marshall, Maury, Smith, Trousdale and Warren counties.

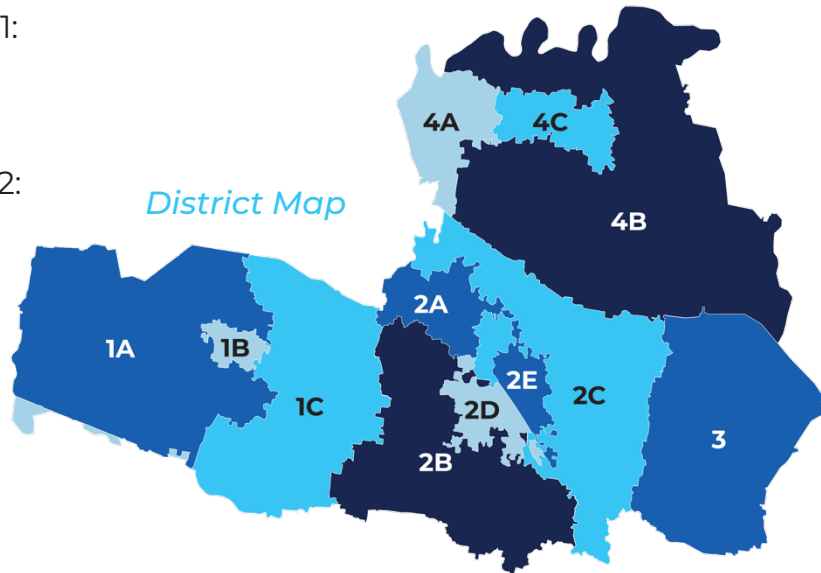
